United States to Frederick Lindquist
The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come-Greeting
Whereas, There has been deposited in the
General Land Office of the United States a
Certificate of the Register of the Land Office
at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby
it appears that pursuant to the Act of Con-
gress approved 20th May 1862 To Sec
Homesteads to actual settlers on the
Domain, and the acts supplemental there-
to, the claim of Frederick Lindquist has
been established and duly consummated in
conformity to law for the East half of the North
East quarter of Section Fourteen (14) in Town-
ship Two (2) North of Range Five (5) East of
Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory,
containing eighty acres, according to the Official
Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned
to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
General;

Know how Ye, That there is, therefore
granted by the United States to the said Fred-
erick Lindquist, and to his heirs and as-
signs forever; subject to any vested and ac-
crued water rights, for mining, agricultural,
manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights
to ditches and reservoirs used in connection
with such water rights, as may be recogni-
zed and acknowledged by the local Customs,
laws, and decisions of Courts, and also subject
to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode
to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should
the same be found to penetrate or intersect
the premises hereby granted, as provided
by law.

In testimony whereof I, Chester A. Arthur
President of the United States of America,
have caused these letters to be made Patent,
and the seal of the General Land Office
to be hereunto affixed.
