NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ON THE 28TH DAY OF MARCH, 1927 AT THE REQUEST OF H. G. DUBOIS THE ABOVE NAMED CLAIMANT COMMENCED TO PERFORM LABOR IN THE OPERATION OF THE SAID BUSINESS OF SAID H. G.
