## NOTICE OF LIEN.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT BYRON SWEENEY OF SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, CLAIMS A LIEN UPON A QUANTITY OF LOGS WHICH WERE CUT IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON AND ARE NOW LYING ON THE SHORE AND IN THE COLUMBIA RIVER AT COOK IN SAID COUNTY, FOR LABOR PERFORMED UPON AND ASSISTANCE RENDERED IN GETTING SAID LOGS OUT; HE ALSO CLAIMS A LIEN UPON ALL DONKEY ENGINES, EQUIPMENT, MATERIAL AND SUPPLIES USED IN GETTING SAID LOGS OUT; THAT THE NAME OF THE OWNER OR REPUTED OWNER IS O. N.
