United States to Mary Haffey.
The United States of America,
To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:
Whereas Mary Haffey of Skamania
County, Washington Territory, has deposited
in the General Land Office of the United
States a Certificate of the Register of the
Land Office at Vancouver, Washington
Territory, whereby it appears that for
payment has been made by Mary Haffey
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress
of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act
making further provision for the sale of the
Public Lands," and the Acts supplement
thereto, for the North West quarter of Section
Ten, in Township Two North of Range Five
East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Ter-
ritory, containing one hundred and sixty acres
according to the Official Plat of the Survey
of the said Lands, returned to the General
Land Office by the Surveyor General, which
Tract has been purchased by the said
Mary Haffey.

Now Know Ye, That the United States
of America, in consideration of the premises
and in conformity with the several Acts of
Congress in such case made and pro-
vided, have given and granted, and
by these presents do give and grant, unto
the said Mary Haffey, and to her heirs
the said Tract, above designated, and
described: To have and to hold the same
together with all the rights, privileges immu-
nities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever
nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Mary
Haffey, and to her heirs and assigns, forever:
subject to any vested water rights as may be
recognized and acknowledged by the local
customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and
also subject to the rights of the proprietor
of a vein or lode to and remove his ore
