O. C. Kaiser to Q. D. Armstrong
CLAIM OF LIEN.

Q. D. ARMSTRONG, Claimant,
vs.
C. C. Daiser, Owner.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That G. D. Armstrong claims a Lien upon a quantity of approximately seventy-threes cords of sixteen inch fir fire wood, now cut and piled upon certain lands owned by G. C. Corlie and W. H. Marshall, located in Skamania County, State of Washington, which said lands are logged-off lands, the merchantable logs having been heretofore removed by Hick's Lumber Company, formerly of Underwood, Skamania County, Washington, the exact legal description of which lands is entirely unknown to the Claimant.

That said Claimant, Q. D. Armstrong, began work upon said wood in February, 1927, and ceased performing labor in cutting and sawing and splitting and piling said wood on the 17th day of October, 1927, said wood being cut and split and piled in Skamania County, State of Washington.

That the name of the owner, or reputed owner, of said fir fire wood is O. C. Kaiser, and that said O. C. Kaiser employed this said claimant to perform such said labor upon the following terms and conditions:

That the said O. C. Kaiser promised and agreed to pay said claimant, Q. D. Armstrong, the sum of \$2.50 per cord for each cord that he cut, sawed, split and piled, he and his partner working together, and that the said O. C. Kaiser has settled with his partner for one-half of the labor so performed, and that the Claimant cut, sawed, split and piled a total of eighty-one (81) cords, which has not been paid for and settled for by the said O. C. Kaiser, the share to the Claimant being \$101.25.

That thirty days have not elapsed since the said time of the performance of the last labor upon said wood by said Claimant, and that the amount of Claimants demand for said labor and services is the sum of \$101.25, and that there is now due and owing Claimant from said O. C. Kaiser the sum of \$101.25, for which said amount Claimant claims a Lien upon said fir fire wood to secure payment for said work and labor in obtaining, and securing, and preparing said wood, as aforesaid.
