Arthur president of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed given under my hand at the City of Washington the seventh day of January in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and eighty five and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and ninth.



THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

To all to whom these presents shall come greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate numbered two hundred and ninety two of the Register and Receiver at Vancouver, Washington Territory whereby it appears that under the provisions of the act of congress approved the 27th day of September 1850 intitled an act to create the office of Surveyor General of the Public lands in Oregon and to provide for the survey and to make donations to Settlers of the said Public lands and the Legislation Supplemental thereto the claim of Bolvar B. Bishop and his wife Luna P. Bishop of Skamania County Washington Territory norification No. 1002 has been established to a donation of one half section or three hundred and twenty acres of land and that the same has been Surveyed and designated, as claim number thirty nine being parts of sections sixteen, seventeen, twenty and twenty one in township two North of Range seven East according to the Official Plat of survey returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General being bounded and described as follows to Wit: Beginning at a point four chains West and thirty chains and fifty links North of the South east corner of the South west quarter of said section sixteen and running thence South sixty chains and eight links; thence south eighty six degrees and forty five minutes West eight chains and fifty links; thence South fifty seven degrees West thirteen chains and sixty links; thence South thirty eight degrees West fifteen chains; thence South twenty three degrees and thirty minutes West three chains and eighty links; thence North forty five degrees West twenty one chains and fifty five links; thence North sixty eight chains and thence east forty five chains and and ninety four links to the place of begining in the district of lands subject to

East quarter (S. E. 1/4) of Section Twelve (12) in
Township three (3) North Range (9) Nine East
Willamette Meridian - Containing Three Hun-
dred and Twenty (320) acres.

To have and to hold the same together
with all and singular the hereditaments and
appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any
wise appertaining thereto to the said George W.
Widler, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
