Notice is hereby given that R.C. Pompella, doing business as the Lincoln Transfer and Storage Co. has and claims a lien upon a quantity of logs being about 124817 ft in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, and marked with the brand H and are now lying in a part of the Little White Salmon River just east of Cocks Washington, this part of the Little White Salmon river is locally designated as Drano Lake.

The Lien is claimed for labor performed and assistance rendered transporting said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner of said logs is T.O. Carney and Angus McCall doing business as the T.O. Carney Logging company.

That the said T.O. Carney acting on his own behalf and the behalf of the partnership employed the above named claimant to transport and haul the logs above described from the logging camp to the river and agreed to pay to the above named claimant the sum of \$2.50 per thousand. That claimant has performed his agreement faithfully. That said services and assistance and hauling was done between the 1st day of April, 1928 and the 1st day of June 1928 and the rendition of said services closed on the 28th day of May 1928 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time. That the amount the claimant demands for said service is the sum of \$312.03; That no part of said sum has been paid except the sum of \$none and there is now due and unpaid, above all just credits and off-sets the sum of \$312.03 in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs mentioned above.

The said above named claimant also claims a lien upon all logs owned by the said T.O. Carney and Angus McCall to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said logs, spars, piles or other timber described herein.
