

"Narrow Gauge" Claim. Bald Mountain Mining District.

Certificate of Location of Quartz Mining Claim.

I, N. C. Peery, a citizen of the United States, hereby certify that on the 15th day of September 1899, I discovered within the limits of the claim hereinafter described a lode of rock in place bearing gold, silver, copper and other valuable minerals; that thereafter, and prior to recording this certificate, I located said claim in the following manner: On the 16th day of October, 1899, I posted at the point of discovery a plain notice, of which the following is a copy, to wit:

Notice of Location.

Notice is hereby given that I, N. C. Peery, a citizen of the United States, have discovered a lode of rock in place carrying gold, silver, copper and other valuable deposits, upon which, at the point of discovery, I have posted this notice.

In accordance with the Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington, I hereby claim fifteen hundred lineal feet of said vein or lode, measured thereon as herein after set forth. The general course of this lode is South 59° 52' East. I claim in length thereon fifteen hundred (1500) feet southeasterly from the point of discovery at which this notice is posted. I also claim thirty-two and one half (32½) feet on each side of the center of said lode.

Said lode is situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Okanogan, State of Washington. It shall be known as the Narrow Gauge lode, and this claim shall be known as the Narrow Gauge Lode Claim. Said discovery was made September 15th 1899.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Washington, I claim ninety days from date of such discovery, to enable me to definitely mark the surface boundaries of the claim, and to otherwise perfect and record the location of said claim.

On the 17th day of October 1899, I marked the surface boundaries of said claim by placing substantial posts bearing the name of the lode and of the claim, and date of location, at each corner of said claim, said posts being not less than three feet high steel pins.

inches in diameter, and cut the brush and marked and blazed the trees along the lines of said claim to indicate the location of said lode.

The general course of said lode is South $59^{\circ} 52'$ East, & claim fifteen hundred linear feet on said lode, to-wit: fifteen hundred (1500) feet in length Southwesterly from point of discovery, and in width thirty two and one half ($32\frac{1}{2}$) feet on each side of the center of said lode, and all mineral deposits contained within the surface boundaries of said claim, as hereinafter described.

Said claim is and shall be known as H. Narrow Gauge Lode claim. Said claim is situated on the southerly side of the Advance Mining Claim in the Bald Mountain Mining District, in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and as marked on the ground the surface boundary of said claim is particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a post in a mound of stone at the Northwest corner of said claim: said post being also the Southwest corner of the Advance Mining Claim: This post is sixteen hundred, sixty six and one half ($1666\frac{1}{2}$) feet North and Five hundred and sixty nine (569) feet west of the Northwest corner of Section numbered twenty eight (28) in Township Three (3) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian: Thence South $59^{\circ} 52'$ East fifteen hundred (1500) feet: Thence South 32° West Sixty four and seven tenths ($64\frac{7}{10}$) feet: Thence North $59^{\circ} 52'$ West: fifteen hundred (1500) feet: Thence North 32° East, Sixty four and seven tenths ($64\frac{7}{10}$) feet to the place of beginning.

And I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
