

render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said T. O. Garney agreed to pay the said claimant 35 cents per thousand for rafting said logs and \$5.00 per day for the time engaged in putting in the boom; that said contract has been faithfully performed on the part of said claimant, and fully complied with, who performed labor upon and assisted in putting in the boom for a period of four days at \$5.00 per day, and that he performed labor upon and rendered assistance in putting up raft no. 13 containing approximately 75000 feet at 35 cents per thousand; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said boom and logs between April 20th, 1928 and August 22nd 1928; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 21st day of August, 1928, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$20.00 for labor on the boom and \$36.25 for labor in making up raft No. 13, making a total sum of \$46.25 due and owing to this claimant; that no part thereof has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid hereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$46.25 in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs.
