Notice is hereby given that Hugh McCall, of Portland, Oregon, claims a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, being about 85 M feet now in a raft in Drano Lake, near Cooks, Skamania County, Wash. and marked "H" on both ends, for labor and assistance rendered in cutting and securing said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Carney Logging Company; that said Carney Logging Company employed said claimant to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms, to-wit;

That the said Carney Logging Company agreed to pay said claimant the sum of \$.62 $\frac{1}{2}$ per hour for such labor and assistance; that said claimant performed labor upon and assistance in securing said saw logs for a period of 891 hours; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 1st day of April 1928 and the 30th day of August 1928, and thirty days have not elapsed

since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services is the sum of \$505.69 and that no part thereof has been paid, and said claimant claims a lien upon said saw-logs is said sum of \$505.69. The said Hugh McCall also claims a lien on all said saw-logs now owned by said Carney Logging Company in said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs herein described.

Notice is hereby given that A. W. Anderson of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon certain logs marked "H" &  the Carney Logging Company brand, and also branded "35" by A. W. Anderson, being about 150,000 feet in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are now lying about 75,000 feet, marked "H" on the beach just east of Cooks and in the lakes just east of Cooks, Skamania County, Washington, and about 75,000 feet, marked "" in the Columbia River, being towed to Vancouver, Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling said logs; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner, of said logs is T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall, co-partners doing business as the Carney Logging Company; that said T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall, co-partners doing business as the Carney Logging Company, employed said claimant to perform such labor and render such assistance upon an expressed agreement to haul said logs at the rate of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per thousand and to work on the rollway of said logs for the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour; that said T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall, co-partners doing business as the Carney Logging Company, agreed to pay said claimant for such labor and assistance the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per thousand for hauling said logs and the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour for working on said rollway; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully
