twenty acres of land and that the same has been surveyed and designated as claim number thirty seven being a part of section thirty one in township three North of Range nine East and claim number thirty nine being a part of section thirty six in township three North of Range eight east according to the Official Plat of survey returned to the general land Office of the surveyor general being bounded and described as follows to wit: Beginning at a point forty six chains and fifty links North and twenty seven chains and fifty links east of the point where the township line between township three North of Range eight east and three North of Range nine East Strikes the Columbia River and running thence, West eighty chains thence South thirty five chains and twenty five links; thence South sixty four degrees and forty five minutes east twenty two chains and eighty links; thence South seventy nine degrees east ten chains and forty links; thence east three chains and fifty links; thence North eighty eight degrees and thirty minutes east eighteen chains and twenty links; thence North eighty one degrees and thirty minutes East ten chains and twenty links; thence North seventy four degrees east eighteen chains and thirteen links and thence North forty chains to the place of begining in the district of lands subject to sale at Vancouver Washington Territory containing three hundred and fifty one acres and twenty one hundredths of an acre. Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the provisions of the act of aforesaid have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said James M. Findley and to his heirs the tract of land above described to have and to hold the said tract with the appurtenances unto the said James M. Findley and to his heirs and assigns forever. Arthur President of the United States have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed, given under my hand at the city of Washington this sixth day of May in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and eighty two and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and sixth.

Means of Madison County Iowa Children and heirs at law of Eliza Marr Means ~~described~~ and as such also heirs at law of Kinzey Marr late of Skamania County Washington Territory deceased parties of the first part and Lewis Marr of Skamania County Washington Territory the party of the second part witnesseth.

That the parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have sold assigned, Transferred and set over and have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed unto him the party of the second part aforesaid all our right, title and interest as heirs at law of the late Kinzey Marr deceased aforesaid and otherwise of in or

 do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey
 to the said David Whitney Jr. his heirs and
 assigns, forever, the parcel of real estate situ-
 ate, lying and being in Skamania County,
 State of Washington, and bounded and
 particularly described as follows. To wit:

The South West quarter of Section Number
 Seventeen (17) in Township Number Three (3)
 North of Range Six (6) East Willamette
 Meridian, said to contain One hundred
 and Sixty Acres (160) more or less, accord-
 ing to the United States Survey.

Together with the tenements, hereditaments
 and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in
 anywise appertaining; and also all our estate
 right, title, and interest, at law and equity
 therein or thereto, including dower and right
 of dower. To have and to hold the same to
 the said David Whitney Jr. his heirs and as-
