

"Portland Mine" claim, - Lookout Mountain Mining District.

Notice of Location

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given, that We the undersigned, a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington, and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of mines, did, on the 30th day of September A.D. 1899, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz claim, known as the Portland Mine Lode or Mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 16th day of September 1899, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Lookout Mt. Mining District, County of Skamania, State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: -

Commencing at this discovery shaft or end, stake and notice one hundred and thirty (130) linear feet to East corner end stake, thence fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a South Westerly Direction to West corner end stake, thence commencing at East corner end stake and running in a Northerly Direction three hundred (300) linear feet to North East corner stake thence fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a South Westerly Direction to North West corner stake, thence three hundred (300) linear feet in a Southerly Direction to West corner end stake, thence three hundred (300) linear feet in a southerly Direction to South West corner stake, thence fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a North Easterly Direction to South East corner stake, thence three hundred (300) linear feet in a northerly Direction to corner end stake place of Beginning.

And We intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of mines and Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
