NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That GEORGE C. HOWARD of Multnomah County, Oregon, claims a lien upon a certain lot of saw logs, being about 250,000 feet, b.m., in quantity, one brail of which is located at a point on the Columbia River known as Ryan Point, in Clark County, Washington, one brail in located at the mouth of Drano Lake near Cooks, in Skamania County, Washington, the balance being inside the boom near Cooks, Washington, in the open Columbia River known as the Snodgrass boom. That the logs are marked variously with the following brands: "G" "H" "31" or "35".

That the name of the owners or reputed owners of the same are D. H. McCall, T. O. Carney, or the Carney Logging Co. defendants above named.

That the claimant George C. Howard claims a lien upon 250,000 feet for stumpage, the same being the agreed purchase price which the defendants above named agreed to pay to this claimant, amounting to \$600.00, as stumpage for said logs, which claimant permitted the defendants to cut from the following described real property, to-wit:

Skamania County, Washington.

That the defendants above named ceased to cut logs upon the premises above described within less than thirty (30) days from the date of this lien notice.

That there is a total sum now due and owing to this claimant for said stumpage upon the timber so cut of \$600.00 over and above all just credits and off-sets, for which amount this claimant now claims a lien on the logs above described.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Fred Cradic, of Portland, Oregon, claims a lien upon a lot of sawlogs, being about seventy thousand feet (70,000,) in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, and marked thus: G; and are lying in the Columbia River on the north bank thereof at a point in Clark county, Washington, known as Ryan Point; the said logs being fir sawlogs of mixed lengths put together as one trail; for labor performed on and assistance rendered in cutting ^{the} said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner, of said logs is Carney Logging Company, a co-partnership consisting of T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall the said Carney Logging Company employing the said Fred Cradic to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms, to-wit: the said Carney Logging Company agreed to pay to said Fred Cradic the sum of Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per day for his labor and assistance in loading; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Fred Cradic, who performed labor upon and assisted in cutting the said logs for the period of twelve (12) days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs between the 31st day of August, 1928 and the 12th day of September, 1928, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 12th day of September, 1928, and that thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of the claimants demand for said services is a balance of Ninety-six and 14/100 dollars (\$96.14); that no part of said sum has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of ninety-six and 14/100 dollars (\$96.14), in which amount he claims a lien upon said sawlogs; and said Fred Cradic also claims a lien on all sawlogs now owned by the said Carney Logging Company, to secure the payment for the work and labor so performed by him on said logs herein described.
