

"Alice Annie Mine" Claim, Lookout Mountain Mining District.

### Notice of Location.

Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October A. D. 1899, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the "Alice Annie" Mine, Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September 1899, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Lookout Mt.
