"Ride of the West" Claim, Lookout Mt. Mining District.

Notice of Location

To Whom It May Concern:

Notice is hereby given, that We the Undersigned a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two, of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington, and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 25th day of October A. D. 1899, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the "Ride of the West" lode or vein mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 10th day of October 1899, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral, in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries), situated in Lookout Mt. Mining District, County of Skamania, State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at this Discovery Shaft or Cut, Stake and Notice two hundred and ninety (290) linear feet in a South West by direction to West Center End Stake, thence fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet North Easterly to East Center End Stake, thence commencing at West Center End Stake and running three hundred (300) linear feet South Easterly to South West Corner Stake, thence fifteen hundred (1500)

lineal feet North Easterly to South East Corner Stake, thence three hundred (300) lineal feet North Westerly to Center End Stake, thence three hundred (300) lineal feet North Westerly to North East Corner Stake, thence three hundred (300) lineal feet South Westerly to the South East Corner Stake of the Mountain Lion Mine thence twelve hundred (1200) lineal feet South Westerly to the North West Corner Stake, thence three hundred lineal feet South Easterly to Center End Stake Place of Beginning.

And We intend to hold and work said claims in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
