LEWIS MARR ADMINISTRATOR & E. TO ELISHA C. CAMERON.
ADMINISTRATORS DEED SEPT. 26, 1887.

This indenture made and entered into this 26th day of September A.D. 1887 by and between Lewis Marr Administrator of the estate of Kinzey Marr deceased late of Skamania County Washington Territory party of the first part and Elisha C. Cameron of the same place party of the second part Witnesseth.

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Whereas in pursuance of an order of Sale of Real estate made and entered on the 25th day of July A.D. 1887 by the Probate Court of Skamania County Washington Territory which said order was entered on that day in the Journal of said Court and is now here referred to and made a part of this instrument the said party of the first part as Administrator aforesaid did on the 20th day of September A.D. 1887 in the manner provided by law sell at public auction to the party of the second part the real estate described in said order of sale and hereinafter described and whereas the said Probate Court did thereafter to wit, on the 26th day of September 1887 make an order duly confirming said sale which said order of confirmation was on that day duly and at large entered of Record in the Journal of said Probate Court and the same is now here referred to and the same constitutes a part of this instrument which said order of confirmation authorized and ~~authorized~~ directed the said party of the first part to make execute and deliver to the said party of the second part a Deed of conveyance of said property now thereon. In consideration of the premises and of the sum of twenty two hundred and thirteen (\$2213.00) dollars (the purchase price of said property bidden as aforesaid on said sale by the party of the second part) the same paid by the said party of the second part at at before the Ex Auction of this instrument the party of the first part has bargained, sold, conveyed and confirmed and by this indenture does grant, bargain, sell and convey and confirm unto him the said party of the second part all the real property aforesaid and particularly described as follows:

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The North half of the North West quarter and Lots two (2) three (3) and four (4) of section four (4) in township one (1) North and the North west quarter of the South west quarter of section thirty four (34) in township two North of range six East, the North west quarter of the North East quarter and Lot (1) of section four (4) and Lot two (2) of section three (3) in township one (1) North and the South West quarter of the South west quarter of section thirty four (34) in township two (2) North of Range six (6) east of the Willamette Meridian containing in the aggregate 388. 25/100 acres situate in Skamania County Washington Territory.

Togeather with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the estate rights and interest of the said deceased therein at the time of his death or which by operation of law or otherwise his estate has acquired therein since his said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.

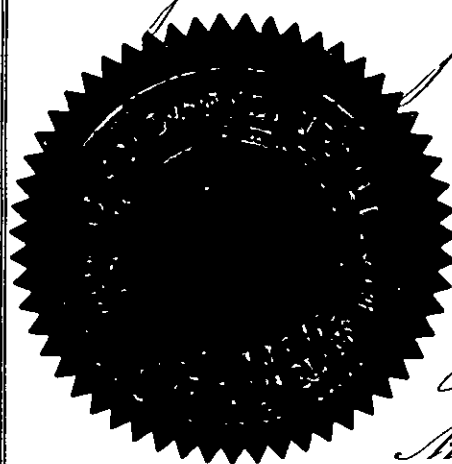

containing 160 acres, be the same more or less.

Together with all and singular the tenements,

appertaining thereto, and also all my estate,
right, title interest, possession, claim of
dower and homestead; and the rents, issues
and profits of, in, and to said real estate;
To have and to hold the same to the said party
of the second part, and to his heirs and as-
signs forever.
