## NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that Gilbert Nord, of Portland Oregon, claims a lien upon a lot of saw logs, being seventy-thousand feet (70,000') in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, and marked thus: ~~G~~ and are lying in the Columbia River on the north bank thereof at a point in Clark County, Washington, known as Ryan Point the said logs being fir sawlogs of mixed lengths put together as one trail; for labor performed on and assistance rendered in cutting the said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner, of said logs is Carney Logging Company, a co-partnership consisting of T.O. Carney and D.H. McCall, the said Carney Logging Company employing the said Gilbert Nord to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms, to-wit : the said Carney Logging Company agreed to pay to said Gilbert Nord the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per day <sup>his</sup> for labor and assistance as hooktender, that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Gilbert Nord, who performed labor upon and assisted in cutting said logs for the period of twelve (12) days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs between the 31st day of August, 1928, and the 12th day of September, 1928, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 12th day of September, 1928, and that thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services <sup>is the balance</sup> of One Hundred Seventeen and 77/100 Dollars (\$117.77); that no part of said sum has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of One Hundred Seventeen and 77/100 Dollars (\$117.77), in which amount he claimed lien upon said sawlogs, said Gilbert Nord also claims a lien on all sawlogs now owned by the said Carney Logging Company, to secure the payment for the work and labor performed by him on said logs herein described.
