NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Irvin Fowler, of Portland Oregon, claims a lien upon a lot of sawlogs, being about seventy thousand (70,000) in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, and marked thus: ~~G~~ and are lying in the Columbia River on the north bank ^{thereof} at a point in Clark County, Washington, known as Bear Point; the said logs being fir sawlogs of mixed lengths put together as one trail; for labor performed ^{on} and assistance rendered in cutting the said logs; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner, of said logs is Carney Logging Company, a co-partnership consisting of T.O. Carney and D.H. McGill, the said Carney Logging Company, employing ^{ing} the said Irvin Fowler to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms, to-wit: the said Carney Logging Company agreed to pay to said Irvin Fowler the sum of Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per day for his labor and assistance in running the Yarder; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Irvin Fowler, who performed labor upon and assisted in cutting the said logs for the period of six (6) days; and that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs between the 5th day of September, 1928, and the 12th day of September, 1928, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 12th day of September, 1928 and that thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services is a balance of Thirty-seven and 14/100 dollars (\$37.14); that no part of said sum has been paid, and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of Thirty-seven and 14/100 Dollars (\$37.14), in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs; said Irvin Fowler also claim a lien on all sawlogs now owned by the said Carney Logging Company, to secure the payment for work and labor performed by him on said logs herein described.
