NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Irvin Fowler, out Portland Oregon, claims a lien upon a lot of sawlogs, being about seventy thousand (70,000) in quantity, which were cut in Skemania County, Washington, and marked thus: (3) and are lying in the Columbia thereof on the north bank at a point in Clark County, Washington, known as F. an Point; the said loge being fir sawlogs of mixed legths put together as one brail; for labor performed and assistance rendered in cutting the said logs; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner, of sail logs is Carney Logging Company, a co-partnership consisting of T.O. Carney and D.H. McCal, the said Carney Logging Company, emply / the said Irvin Fowler to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms, to-wit: the said Carney Logning Companyagreed to pay to said Irvin Fowler the sum of Sever Jollars (\$7.00) per day for his labor and assistance in running the Yarder; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Irvin Fowler, who perfo med labor upon and assisted in cutting the said logs for traperiod of six(6) days; and that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs between the 5th day of September, 1928, and the 12th day of September, 1928, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 12th day of September, 1928 and that thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services is a balance of Thirtyseven and 14/100 dollars (\$37.14); that no part of said sum has been paid, and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and effsets, the sum of Thirty-seven and 14/100 Doblars (\$37,14), in which amount he slaims a lien upon said saw logs; said Irvin Fowler also claim a lien on all sawlogs now owned by the said Carney Logging Company, to secure the payment for work and labor performed by him on said logs herein described.
