

Mountain Lion Claim. Lookout Mt. Mining District.

Notice of Location.

To Whom It May Concern:

Notice is hereby given, That We the Undersigned a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Five of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 23rd day of October A.D. 1899, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the Mountain Lion Mine Lode or Mining Claim, said lode, having been discovered the 5th day of October 1899, and d. claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries), situated in Lookout Mt. Mining District County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at this discovery shaft or pit, stake and thence four hundred and ten (410) linear feet in a South Westerly direction to West Center End Stake, thence fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet North Easterly to East Center End Stake thence commencing at West Center End Stake and running in a Northerly direction along the lode etc. is Mine three hundred (300) linear feet to North West Corner Stake thence fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet North Easterly to North East Corner Stake, thence three hundred (300) linear feet South Easterly to Center End Stake, thence three hundred linear feet South Easterly to South East Corner Stake, thence fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a South Westerly direction to South West Corner Stake joining the Alice Annie Mine thence three hundred (300) linear feet Northerly to Center End Stake. Place of Beginning.

And We intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
