 claimant : NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Ray Whitney, of Seattle, Washington, claims a lien on a lot of sawlogs, being about seventy-thousand feet (70,000') in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, and marked thus: G, and are lying in the Columbia River on the north bank thereof at a point in Clark County, Washington, known as Ryan Point; said logs being fir sawlogs of mixed lengths put together as one brail; also upon a second lot of sawlogs, being about seventy thousand feet (70,000) in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, and marked thus: H, and are lying in Drano Lake, near the mouth thereof, in Skamania County, Washington, the said logs being fir sawlogs of mixed lengths constituting one brail known as Brail No. 13, for labor performed on and assistance rendered in cutting the said logs; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner, of said logs is Carney Logging Company, a co-partnership consisting of T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall, the said Carney Logging Company employing the said Ray Whitney to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms; the said Carney Logging Company agreed to pay the said Ray Whitney the sum of 50¢ per hour for labor as woodsplitter; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Ray Whitney, who performed labor upon and rendered assistance in cutting the said logs for the period of twenty-four (24) days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs between the 15th day of August and the 11th day of September, 1928, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 11th day of September, 1928, and that thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is a balance of Forty-three dollars (\$43.00); that no part of said sum has been paid and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of Forty-three Dollars (\$43.00), in which amount he claims a lien upon said sawlogs; and said Ray Whitney also claims a lien upon all sawlogs now owned by the said Carney Logging Company to secure the payment for the work and labor so performed by him on said logs herein described.
