NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Martin Fallon, of Seattle, Washington, claims a lien on a lot of sawlogs, being about seventy thousand feet (70,000') in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, and marked thus: G., and are lying in the Columbia River on the North bank thereof at a point in Clark County, Washington, known as Ryan Point; said logs being fir sawlogs of mixed lengths put together as one brail; also upon a second lot of sawlogs, being about seventy thousand feet (70,000') in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, and marked thus: H. and are lying in Drano Lake, near the mouth thereof, in Skamania County, Washington, the said logs being fir sawlogs of mixed lengths constituting one brail known as Brail No. 13, for labor performed and assistance rendered in cutting the said logs; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner, of said logs is Carney Logging Company, a co-partnership consisting of T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall, the said Carney Logging Company employing the said Martin Fallon to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms: the said Carney Logging Company agreed to pay the said Martin Fallon the sum of 50¢ per hour for labor as woodbucker and One Dollar (\$1.00) per day extra for labor performed as filer; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Martin Fallon, who performed labor upon and rendered assistance in cutting the said logs for the period of forty-nine days (49da.); that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs between the 24th day of July, 1928, and the 11th day of September, 1928, the labor as filer having begun on the 1st day of August, 1928, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 11th day of September, 1928, and that thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is a balance of One Hundred Fifty-two and 81/100 Dollars (\$152.81); that no part of said sum has been paid and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of One Hundred Fifty-two and 81/100 Dollars (\$152.81), in which amount he claims a lien upon ^{said} sawlogs; and said Martin Fallon also claims a lien upon all sawlogs now owned by the said Carney Logging Company to secure the payment for the work and labor so performed by him on said logs herein described.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That C. A. Beck and A. Streid, co-partners doing business under the the name of Beck & Streid, of 227, E 3rd St. Portland, Oregon, claim a lien upon a quantity of logs, being about 200,000 feet in quantity, which were cut and manufactured in Skamania county, Washington, there being one raft or "brail" of said logs at Ryan point near Vancouver Washington, in the Columbia river, being designated at Brail No. 14, containing approximately 60,000 feet of said logs marked 14; there being one raft or "brail" of said logs in Drano Lake near Cooks, Skamania County, Washington, designated as brail No. 13, containing approximately 80,000 feet, and marked "H" and also marked "31"; there being also about 40,000 of said logs in a boom in the Columbia River marked 13. The said lien is so claimed for work and labor performed upon and assistance rendered hauling said logs from the woods where produced to Drano Lake, and to the Columbia River, near Cooks, in Skamania county, Washington; that the name of the owners, or reputed owners of said logs are T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall, co-partners doing business under the name of Carney Logging Company; that claimants were employed to perform said labor and work, and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions to-wit;

That the said owners, T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall, co-partners agreed to pay the said claimants the sum of \$3.00 per thousand feet, log measure for hauling said logs by truck from the woods to the said Drano Lake and Columbia River, near Cooks, Washington; that pursuant to said agreement the said claimants commenced hauling said logs on the 24th day of June 1928, and fully performed the said contract on their part and fully complied with all the terms thereof; that claimants so performed said labor and rendered such assistance in hauling said logs for a period of two months and 15 days; that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered between the said 24th day of June 1928 and the 8th day of September 1928, and the rendition of said services was closed on the said 8th day of September 1928 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the said claimants so hauled a total of 397,489 feet of said logs, and the total amount of their claim for said services is the sum of \$1,192.46; that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$765.21 cash and the sum of \$130.25 for board, commissary supplies and hospital fees, making a total credit to said owners of the sum of \$895.46, and leaving a balance of \$297.00 now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, in which sum they now claim a lien upon said logs. The said C. A. Beck and A. Streid co-partners also claim a lien on all said logs now owned by said T. O. Carney and D. H. McCall, co-partners doing business as Carney Logging Company in said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in hauling said logs herein described.
