Whereas James Nevin of Skamania County Washington Territory has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a ~~xxxx~~ Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said James Nevin according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th day of April 1820 entitled an act making further provisions for the sale of the public lands and the acts supplemental thereto for the North west ~~xxxxxx~~ quarter of the North East quarter and the North east quarter of the North west quarter of Section fourteen in township to North of range five east of the Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory containing eighty acres.

According to the Official plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said James Nevin now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and the conformity with the several acts of Congress in which case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said James Nevin and to his heirs the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of what soever nature thereunto belonging unto the said James Nevin and to his heirs and assigns forever subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining agricultural, manufacturing ~~xx~~ or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs ~~xxxxxx~~ used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate ~~xxxx~~ or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law. In testimony whereof I, Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed given under my hand at the city of Washington the third day of September in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty seven and of the Independence of the United States the one hundredth and twelfth.
