This article of agreement made and entered into this 30th day of October A.D. 1886 by and between S.M. Hamilton and Mary J. Hamilton his wife parties of the first part and J.W. McGowan, Wm. Buchheit Jr and J.D. McGowan comprising the firm of McGowan, Buchheit & Co, parties of the second part witnesseth that the parties of the first part in consideration of the covenants and agreement hereinafter set out to be performed by the parties of the second part to the parties of the first part have bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns for the term of twenty (20) years from this date the right of fishing on the Land of the parties of the first part fronting on the Columbia river Lower Cascades Washington Territory except that part which is leased to the O.R. & Nav. Co and the parties of the second part shall have the right to build and operate one or more fish wheels or traps or both and structures necessary thereto on the said Land and the parties of the second part in consideration of the exclusive right of putting in such wheels or traps as above set forth do hereby agree to give unto the parties of the first part one third of all the fish caught by said wheels or traps. The said parties of the first part hereby undertake and agree to sell to the parties of the second part for the term of five (5) years their said one third of all the fish at one and one quarter (1 $\frac{1}{4}$) cents per pound gross weight for merchantable Salmon and Blue backs six (6) cents per fish for Steel heads of good color excepting in case of the inability of the Cannery of the parties of the second part to receive the same after the aforesaid first five (5) years have elapsed the price for the party of the first part one third of the fish to be agreed upon and it is fully understood by and between the parties or hereto that in case of accident to any of the wheels or traps whereby they become inoperative or incable of being worked it shall not be construed as an abandonment of the fishing rights hereby conveyed the parties of the first part shall be under no expense to build or operate any of the said wheels or traps.

whom these presents shall come Greeting:
Whereas Katharine H. King, of Pierce County,
Washington Territory has deposited in the
General Land Office of the United States a
certificate of the Register of the Land Office
at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby
it appears that full payment has been
made by the said Katharine H. King, accor-
ding to the provisions of the Act of Congress
of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act
making further provision for the Sale of the
Public Lands," and the acts supplemental
thereto, for the North East quarter of Section
Eight in Township two North of Range Six
East of Willamette Meridian, in Washing-
ton Territory, containing one hundred and
sixty acres, according to the Official
Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, re-
turned to the General Land Office by the
Surveyor General, which said Tract has
been purchased by the said Katharine
H. King.

Now Know Ye, That the United States
of America, in Consideration of the premises
and in conformity with the several Acts of
Congress in such case made and provided
have given and granted, and by these pres-
ents do give and grant unto the said
Katharine H. King, and to her heirs and as-
signs forever; subject to any vested and
accrued water rights for mining agricul-
tural, manufacturing, or other purposes,
and the rights to ditches and reservoirs
used in connection with such water rights
as may be recognized and acknowledged
by the customs, laws and decisions of Courts
and also subject to the right of proprietor
of a vein or lode, to extract and remove his
ore therefrom, should the same be found to
