That sa'l Louis Pearson agreed to pay the said claimant for such labor and assistance \$6.00 per day, less board of \$1.20 per day laeving a net wage of \$4.80 per day due calimant; that said contract has beenfai thfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said claimant, who performed labor upon and assisted in the procuring said logs, piling, and poles and worked upon and about said machinery and equipment and comissary building for the period of 13 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and fendered between the 9th day of Feb. 1929 and the 27th day of Feb. 1929; That the redition of said services w was closed on the 26th day of Feb. 1929 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of the calimants demand for said service is \$60.30 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$60.30 in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs, piling, poles, donkey engine, lines, equipment, comissary building; the said claimant also calims a lien on all said logs, piles, poles, donkey engines, lines, equipment tools, buildings now owned by said Louis Pearson or his associates or in which he or they have or may have an interest to secure payment for the worl a and labor performed in obtaining and securing said logs, piling, poles, and work in connection with said donkey engine, lines, equipment, building etc,.
