

"16 to 1" claim. Bald Mountain Mining District.

Notice of Amended Location of Quartz Mining claim.

Notice is hereby given, that I, Jonathan Bourne Jr., a citizen of the United States, having complied with the requirements of the laws of the United States and of the State of Washington, and the local customs, laws and regulations, have located and claim by virtue of the original discovery and location and this amended certificate of location, eight hundred and twenty-one (821) linear feet on this the Last Chance lode of mineral bearing quartz, and three hundred (300) feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, together with all mineral deposits contained therein, and all mines growing within the limits of said claim, and all water and water privileges thereon or appurtenant thereto. This claim is situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District, in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and is now and shall be known as the 16 to 1 Mining claim.

The general course of said lode is North $61^{\circ} 22'$ West and I claim in length on said lode eight hundred and twenty-one (821) feet Northwestwardly from the point of discovery, at which point I have posted an original duplicate of this notice. I have marked the surface boundaries of this claim by placing substantial posts not less than three feet high and four inches in diameter at each corner of said claim, bearing the name of the lode and of the claim and the date of location, and have cut the brush and marked and blazed the trees along the lines of said claim to indicate the location of said lines.

The surface boundary of this claim is particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a post on a mound of stone, at the Northeast corner of said claim; said post is One thousand and two (1002) feet North and seven hundred fifty one and one half ($175\frac{1}{2}$) feet West of the Southwest corner of Section Twenty Eight (28) in Township Three (3) North $\frac{1}{2}$ Range Five (5) East of 1° Willamette Meridian:

Thence North $61^{\circ} 22'$ West eight hundred and twenty-one (821) feet; thence South $40^{\circ} 15'$ West, six hundred (600) feet; thence South $61^{\circ} 22'$ East eight hundred and twenty-one (821) feet; thence North $40^{\circ} 15'$ East, six hundred (600) feet, to the place of beginning:

And I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.

This is an amended location of the 16 to 1 claim, discovered by C. A. Rathbone and J. C. Lawton on the 16th day of April 1897, and located on the 16th day of April 1897, and recorded at page 526 of Book "C" of Miscellaneous Records of Skamania County, Washington. I now declare the owner of said claim by purchase and conveyance from said original locator.

This amended certificate of location is made without waiver of any rights previously acquired by me by virtue of said original location, purchase and conveyance, and for the purpose of correcting any errors in the original location, description or record of said claim, and of taking in any additional ground which is subject to location, and any part of any overlapping claim which has been abandoned.
