Caples & Lowe to H. Graves

H. Graves Claimant, vs Caples and Lowe, a co-partnership composed of Henry R. Caples and R. A. Lowe, owners

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 15th day of January 1929 at the request of Caples and Lowe, a co-partnership composed of Henry Caples and R. A. Lowe, the undersigned, H. Graves, commenced to furnish material and perform labor for and upon the dance hall building, known as the Cascade Dance Hall, being a building owned and occupied by the above named Henry Caples and R. A. Lowe, co-partners, situated and being upon that certain property described in a certain contract for sale and purchase, dated the 8th day of September 1927, and recorded on the 29th day of September 1927 at page 404-406 Book V of Deeds, records of Skamania County, Washington, to which record reference is hereby made for a more complete and definite description, the said building being located upon said property approximately 125 feet northerly from State Road No 8 and approximately 50 feet east of Hamilton Slough: that the owners of said building and property or the reputed owners thereof, are the said Henry Caples and R. A. Lowe: that the performance of said labor, and the furnishing of said material, ceased on the 18th day of January 1929; that said material was furnished and labor performed in finishing the floor of said building under an agreed price therefor of \$120.00, and was of the value of \$120.00: that said owners promised and agreed to pay therefor the said sum of \$120.00, but no part thereof has been paid excepting the sum of \$7.00, and there is now due and owing claimant therefor the sum of \$113.00. That the undersigned claimant claims a lien against and upon the property herein described in said sum of \$113.00 for said labor and material performed

and furnished as aforesaid. *October 1929*
I hereby cancel this lien claim, if same having been fully paid and discharged.
