NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That Heroert Edwards of Skamania County, State of Washington claims a lien upon a quantity of poles, logs and piling out and on the beach at Cooks, Skamania County, Washington which were cut or manufactured in said County, State of Washington. Said labor is for assistance rendered in driving team and building roads to get the poles, logs and piling from said mill. That the name of the owner or reputed owner is A. C. Hitchman; that A. C. Hitchman employed said Herbert Edwards to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said A. C. Hitchman agreed to pay the said Herbert Edwards for such labor and assistance the sum of Four (\$4.00) Dollars per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Heroert Edwards, who performed labor upon and assisted in driving team and building roads for the period of twenty-two (22) days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs, poles and piling between the 7th day of August and the 31st day of August, 1929; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 31st day of August, 1929, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$88.00; that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$10.00, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$78.00, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs, poles and piling. The said Herbert Edwards also claims a line on all said logs, poles and piling now owned by said A. C. Hitchman of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, piling and poles herein described.

LIEN NOTICE

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that Arthur Geherke of Clarke County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, spars, piles and other timber, being about unknown lineal feet of spars and piles and eight hundred thousand feet of saw logs and other timber, in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington; are marked thus, some are marked with "C" brand but mostly unmarked and are now lying in or about what is known as the Vial tract and the Thomas tract in Sec. 6 T 1 N. R. 6 E. W. M. in Skamania County, Wash. and (or) in, and on the bank of the Columbia River near Prindle, Wash., for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in obtaining and securing said saw logs, spars, piles and other timber; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is A. D. Craig, C. L. Osborne and Otto Peters, co-partners, doing business under the name and style of the "Columbia Logging Company"; that said owners employed said Arthur Geherke to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said owners agreed to pay the said Arthur Geherke for such labor and assistance at the rate of \$4.00 per day; that said contract has been fully performed and fully complied with on the part of said claimant, who performed labor upon and assisted in obtaining and securing said saw logs, spars, piles and other timber for the period of 4 3/16 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said saw logs, spars, piles and other timber between the 27th day of August, 1928, and the 30th day of August, 1929, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 30th day of August, 1929, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$16.75; that no part thereof has been paid except \$9.92, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$6.83, in which amount he claims a Lien upon the said saw logs, spars, piles, and other timber. That said Arthur Geherke also claims a Lien on all said saw logs, spars, piles and other timber now owned by said A. D. Craig, C. L. Osborne and Otto Peters, Co-partners, doing business under the name and style of the "Columbia Logging Company" located in said Skamania County to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said saw logs, spars, piles or other timber herein described.
