NOTICE OF LIEN.

Harry Conniff & L.G. Westfall Partners,  
doing business as Green Tree Lumber Company.

Notice is hereby given that Edward J. Brazell, of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, claims a lien upon a certain quantity being all of the saw logs, spars, piles, timber and lumber which were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and which are now lying at and about the Mill of the Green Tree Lumber Company, two miles east of Collins, on the North Bank Railroad, in Skamania County, Washington, the same being in Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32, Township 3 N. Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, for work, labor and skill performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting and manufacturing same in said Skamania County, Washington, by one John H. Johnson.

That the names of owners or reputed owners of said logs, spars, piles, timber and lumber are Harry Conniff and L.G. Westfall, partners doing business under the name and title of Green Tree Lumber Company. That the said Conniff and Westfall employed said J.H. Johnson to perform such labor, and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions to wit:

The said Conniff and Westfall agreed to pay to said J.H. Johnson, for such labor and assistance the sum of \$15.15. that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of J.H. Johnson, who performed labor upon and assisted in cutting and obtaining said logs, spars, piles, timber and lumber in said Skamania County, Washington; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs, spars, piles, timber and lumber between the first day of April, 1913 and the third day of May, 1913, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services in \$15.15 that no part thereof has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid after deducting all just credits and off sets the sum of \$15.15 in which amount said Edward J. Brazell claims a lien upon said logs, spars, piles, timber and lumber.

The said Edward J. Brazell also claims a lien upon the Saw Mill of the said Green Tree Lumber Company, near Collins in Skamania County, Washington, and all the real and personal property, donkey engines, cable, and other appurtenances which are owned by and used in the operation of the business of the said Green Tree Lumber Company for and on account of said work, labor and skill done and performed by said J.H. Johnson as aforesaid.

That prior to the date hereof and within thirty days after the completion and rendition of said work, labor and skill the said J.H. Johnson, for a valuable consideration, transferred assigned and set over unto said Edward J. Brazell, his claim of lien, his lien and his right to file a lien and also his right to enforce and foreclose the same against said logs, spars, piles, timber and lumber and the saw mill of the said Green Tree Lumber Company and all real and personal property, and donkey engines, cable and other appurtenances of said Green Tree Lumber Company; and said Edward J. Brazell is now holder and owner of said lien and right of lien.
