

Notice of Re-location "Lunenburg" Mining Claim

To Whom it may Concern:

Notice is hereby given, That D. W. Ward Citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 17th day of January A. D. 1898, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the Lunenburg Lode or Mining Claim said claim having been discovered on the 4th day of October 1897 and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs, branches, and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries (twenty acres of placer mining ground), situated in Copper Creek Mining District County of Skamania, State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at center of Discovery shaft and notice about half way between Copper Creek and Charley Creek near center of Section (4) Township (3) Range 10 S. E. W. M. It runs 1500 feet in a Northwesterly direction to center end stake a large Fir tree blazed and three notches cut as witness tree at South end of the H. E. Catterfield Lode on the Ida Martin Claim and about (300) Three Hundred feet from the shaft now being sunk on the Yellow Bird Claim, thence 300 feet in a Westerly direction to the North West corner stake center of Copper Creek & former corner of the Lunenburg & Ida Martin Claim, thence 1500 feet in a Southerly direction down the center of Copper Creek along the end line of the Yellow Bird Claim and then Southerly located by D. W. Manning and across the corner of the Yellow Claim located by C. Cole to the South

North Corner Stake Thence 300 feet in a Easterly direction to the center end stake & center of Discovery Shaft the north one half of said shaft is on the Genovio's Claim & south one half on the Bulger Claim, Thence 300 feet in a Easterly direction to the South East Corner Stake, Thence 1500 feet in a Northerly direction to the North East Corner Stake, Thence 300 feet in a Westerly direction to center end stake. The former side line between the Ida Marton Claim and Genovio's Claim now becomes the North end line of the Genovio's Claim

And I intend to hold and work said claims in accordance with the local customs and rules of mines and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington
