

Notice of Re-location "Lorraine" Mining Claim

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given, that
 D. W. Ward Citizen of the United States of America,
 over the age of twenty-one years, having complied
 with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two
 of the General Statutes of the United States and of
 all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of
 Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and
 regulations of miners, did on the 17th day of January
 A.D. 1898, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate
 a Quartz Claim, known as the Lorraine, located on Mining
 Claim said claim having been discovered on the
 4th day of October 1897 and do claim fifteen thousand
 feet square feet on this land, bed or vein bearing
 mineral in place, six hundred feet in width, the
 same being three hundred feet on each side of the center
 thereof, together with all dikes, spurs, angles, and all
 other veins or beds the top or apex of which lie
 within said boundaries (twenty acres of placer
 mining ground) situated in Cope Creek Mining Dis-
 trict County of Skamania, State of Washington said loca-
 tion being described as I distinctly manifest by reference
 to natural objects or permanent monuments and
 more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

By running at center of Discovery shaft and notice
 about half way between Cope Creek and Charley Creek
 near center of Section (4) Township (3) Range R. 5
 E. P. M. It runs 1500 feet in a Northwesterly direction
 to center and takes a long turn elongated and the
 notches such as, pictures tree at south end of the N.E.
 corner of the old Martin claim and
 about (300) Three Hundred feet from the shaft down
 being sunk on the Yellow Bird claim, thence 300
 feet in a southerly direction to the Northwest corner
 state center of Cope Creek & former corner of the
 Lorraine & old Martin claim. Thence 1500 feet in a Southwesterly
 direction down the center of Cope Creek along the end
 line of the Yellow Bird claim and the Lorraine claim
 located by F. G. Manning and across the corner
 of the Yellow Bird claim located by C. Cole, the south

West corner Stake Thence 300 feet in a Easterly direction to the center and stake + center of Discovery Shaft the North one half of said shaft is on the Geneva Claim & South one half on the Bulger claim, Thence 300 feet in a Easterly direction to the South East corner Stake, Thence 1500 feet in a Northerly direction to the North East corner Stake, Thence 300 feet in a Westward direction to center and stake, The former side line between the Ada Morton Claim and Geneva claims now becomes the North end line of the Geneva Claim.

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of mines and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington
