This instrument made and entered into this the 8th day of September in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight-hundred and eighty six by and between J. P. Means of Skamania County Washington Territory, Son and heir at law of Eliza Marr means deceased and as such also heir at law of Kinney Marr late of Skamania County Washington Territory deceased party of the first part and Lewis Marr of Skamania County Washington Territory the party of the second part witnesseth

That the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of ten Dollars to him in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have sold assigned transferred and set over and have granted bargained sold and conveyed unto him the party of the second part aforesaid all my right title and interest as heir at law of the late Kinney Marr deceased aforesaid and otherwise of in or to all and singular the real and personal property and the estate and effects of every kind and nature in said Territory of Washington belonging to him said Kinney Marr deceased at the time of his death or in which his estate has since his said death has acquired any interest or title whatsoever to gather with all and singular the rights franchises appurtenances and hereditaments thereunto belonging in any wise appertaining to me as such heir at law of the said Kinney Marr deceased and to the estate and property aforesaid as fully to all intents and purposes as though he the said party of the second part were the sole heir at law of the deceased passing aforesaid to have and to hold to him the said party his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof the said party of the first part have hereunto set their hands and seal the day and year aforesaid
