This Indenture made and entered into this the 8th day of September in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and eighty ~~seven~~ six and between J. P. Means of Kamanna County Washington Territory son and heir at law of Eliza Marr Means deceased and as such also heir at law of Kinzey Marr late of Kamanna County Washington Territory deceased party of the first part and Lewis Marr of Kamanna County Washington Territory the party of the second part Witnesses

That the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of ten Dollars to him in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have sold assigned transferred and set over and have granted bargained sold and conveyed unto him the party of the second part aforesaid all my right title and interest as heir at law of the late Kinzey Marr deceased aforesaid and otherwise of in or to all and singular the real and personal property and of the estate and effects of every kind and nature in said Territory of Washington belonging to him said Kinzey Marr deceased at the time of his death or in which his estate has since his said death has acquired any interest or title whatsoever together with all and singular the rights privileges appurtenances and hereditaments thereunto belonging in any wise appertaining to me as such heir at law of the said Kinzey Marr deceased and to the estate and property aforesaid as fully to all intents and purposes as though he the said party of the second part were the sole heir at law of the deceased last aforesaid to have and to hold to him the said party his heirs and assigns forever in Witness whereof the said party of the first part have hereunto set my hand and affixed the day and year above written
