NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That L. G. Fiske of Portland, Oreg. claims a lien upon quantity of piling, being 69 pieces lying on a rollway on the south side of the S. P. & S Ry, and on the bank of the Columbia River, about 150 feet south of said railroad at the junction of the Cascades Spur thereof; also upon a quantity of logs or piling, being about 60 M feet log scale, piled along the Cascade Spur of the S. P. & S. Railway, near the station of Cascades in Skamania, County, Washington; for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in securing said piling and logs: that said piling and logs were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, and the owner, or reputed owner thereof, is

That the said C. Pearson, employed the claimant to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said claimant was so employed by the said owner to haul the said logs and piling to the loading places, above mentioned, at the agreed price of $1\frac{1}{2}$ cent per lineal foot for the piling having a 12" butt; $1\frac{1}{2}$ cents per lineal foot for piling having a 14" butt, and the sum of 3 cents per lineal foot for piling having a 22" butt; that claimant so hauled 2566 lineal feet of 12" butt piling; 3335 feet of 14" butt piling and 5615 feet of 22" butt piling, for which the said owner became indebted to claimant in the sum of \$250.57; that claimant also performed labor and rendered assistance in securing said logs and piling in hauling a donkey engine for which said owner agreed to pay the claimant the sum of \$15.00. That said work and labor was faithfully performed, and claimant's agreement fully complied with by claimant; that said work was commenced on the 15th day of August 1929, and said work and assistance was so performed and rendered between said 15th day of August 1929 and the 4th day of September 1929, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 4th day of September 1929, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's claim and demand for said service is the sum of \$265.57, no part of which has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the said sum of \$265.57 in which amount he claims a lien upon said piling and logs. That the said claimant also claims a lien on all said logs and piling now owned by said C. Pearson of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining and securing the said logs and piling herein described.
