Whereas John Rabern of Skamania County of Washington Territory has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Rabern according to the Provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an act making further provisions for the sale of the public Lands and the act supplemental thereto for the north half of the North west quarter the south east quarter of the north west quarter and the lot numbered one or section twenty six in township three north of range eight east of the Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory containing one hundred and fifty acres and sixty hundredth of an acre according to the official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said John Rabern.

Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Rabern and to his heirs the said tract above described.

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To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said John Rabern and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights forming agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water right as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs laws and decisions of courts and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law.

In testimony whereof I, Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the first day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and sixth.
