NOTICE OF LIEN

Notice is hereby given that Rose O'Brien of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon two (2) rafts of fir saw logs being about two hundred thousand (200,000) feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, part of which are marked thus: (K) and part of which are marked thus: (V) and are now lying at St. Cloud approximately two (2) miles east of Prindle in Skamania County, Washington, for labor performed and assistance rendered in cutting, procuring, and manufacturing said saw logs, as cook.

That the owners or reputed owners are C. L. Osborne, A. D. Craig, and Otto Peters, co-partners doing business as the Columbia Logging Company.

That the said C. L. Osborne, A. D. Craig, and Otto Peters employed the said Rose O'Brien to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That the said C. L. Osborne, A. D. Craig, and Otto Peters, co-partners doing business as the Columbia Logging Company, agreed to pay the said Rose O'Brien for such labor and assistance at the rate of One Hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars per month; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Rose O'Brien, who performed labor upon and assisted in procuring, cutting, and manufacturing said saw logs for the period of six months; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said saw logs, between the 9th day of March, 1929 and the 7th day of September, 1929; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 7th day of September, 1929, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$941.27; that no part thereof has been paid except \$200.00, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$741.27 in which amount she claims a lien upon the said saw logs. The said Rose O'Brien also claims a lien on all of said saw logs now owned by C. L. Osborne, A. D. Craig, and Otto Peters, co-partners doing business as the Columbia Logging Company of said county to secure payments for work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
