LIEN CLAIM

MOTICE IN WEIGHT GIVEN that Mark Pearson of Portland, Oregon, hereby claims a lien upon a certain quantity of fir logs and piling described as follows, to-wit;

70 pieces, 50 to 85 ft. long, lo to 22 in. in diameter at the butt now piled on Sec. 21, T. 2 N. R. 7 East, along the railway siding upon a sour owned by Potts lumber Company in Skamania County, Eashington:

30 pieces, 60 to 70 ft. long 8 in. in diameter at the top, now piled on the bank of the Columbia River about 150 st. south of the railroad track at the junction of the Casacade's spur in said township and range;

40 pieces, 40 to 60 ft. long, 12 in. at the butt;

40 pieces, 3 in. at the top and about 60 to 70 ft. long, located upon the D. L. g. of O. W. Er them on the rollway and in the woods in Sections 19 and 20, T. 2 N. R. 7 East of the Will. Mer. in said county;

That said lien is claimed for labor and services performed in cutting, securing, handling and piling said logs and piling; that all the said logs and piling were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, and the owner or reputed owner thereof is the said C. Pearson;

That the said 3. Pearson employed the claimant to perform said labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: At the rate of \$5.00 per day for 12 days and 47½ days running donkey at \$6.00 per day, making a total of 59½ days, between July 21, 1929 and Sept. 21, 1929; that said labor and services were faithfully performed and thirty days have not elapsed since the completion of said services: that the total amount of claimant's claim and demand for said services is the sum of \$345.00 after deducting all just debits and offsets and said claimant claims a lien upon said piling and logs in said sum; that no part of said sum has ever been paid; that said claimant also claims a lien upon any and all other logs and piling now coined by the said C. Pearson to secure payment for the said work and labor so performed in securing said logs and piling hereinbefore described.
