Have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Pluma Leavens and to her heirs the said tracts above described. To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Pluma Leavens and to her heirs and assigns forever.
