Notice is Hereby Given that Mrs. E. Nyland of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of logs located on what is known as the T. J. Vail place and Camas Tract in Section <sup>Six</sup> (6) Township One (1) North Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, and also in rafts or log boom of the said company in the Columbia River adjacent to the above premises, all near Prindle, Skamania County, State of Washington, being about One hundred Forty Thousand (140,000) feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are marked thus V P C and located on the above described premises, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cooking; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner is the Columbia Logging Company; that Olaf Lundy employed said Mrs. E. Nyland to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: The said Olaf Lundy agreed to pay the said Mrs. E. Nyland for such labor and assistance the sum of \$100.00 per month Dollars; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Mrs. E. Nyland, who performed labor upon and assisted in cooking, said cooking for the period of One month and twenty-three days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said above described property between the 28th day of September, 1929 and the 31st day of October 1929; and the rendition of said service was closed on the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 1929, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is One Hundred Seventy-six & 66/100 Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid except Twenty-four and 44/100 Dollars, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of One Hundred Fifty-two & 22/100 Dollars in which amount he claims a lien upon said property hereinbefore described. The said Mrs. E. Nyland also claims a lien upon all of said logs located upon what is known as the Vail place and Camas Tract in Section Six (6) Township One (1) North Range six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, and also in rafts or log boom of the said company in the Columbia River adjacent to the above premises, all near Prindle, Skamania County, State of Washington, being about One Hundred Forty Thousand (140,000) feet in quantity, which were marked thus \_\_\_\_\_ and located upon the above described premises, now owned by said Columbia Logging company, and A. J. Surbeck as Trustee, of said County, to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
