CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Erick Nyland of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of logs located on what is known as the T. J. Vail place and James tract in Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, and also in rafts or log boom of the said company in the Columbia River adjacent to the above premises, all near Prindle, Skamania County, State of Washington, being about one Hundred Forty Thousand (140,000) feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus   V   P   C    and located on the above described premises, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in sawing wood around the donkey; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner is the Columbia Logging Company; that Olaf Lundy employed Erick Nyland to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: The said Olaf Lundy agreed to pay the said Erick Nyland for such labor and assistance the sum of Five Dollars & Five & 50/100 Dollars; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Erick Nyland who performed labor upon and assisted in sawing wood around donkey said                      for the period of Fifty-one & one half days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said above described property between the 9th day of September and the 31st day of October, 1929; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 31st day of October, 1929, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is Two Hundred Seventy-six & 75/100 Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid except Eighty-four & 63/100 Dollars, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of One Hundred Ninety-two & 6/100 Dollars, in which amount he claims a lien upon said property hereinbefore described. The said Erick Nyland also claims a lien on all said logs located upon what is known as the Vail place and James tract in Section Six (6) Township One (1) North, Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, and also in rafts or log boom of the said company in the Columbia River adjacent to the above premises, all near Prindle, Skamania County, State of Washington, being about one Hundred Forty Thousand (140,000) feet in quantity, which were marked thus                      and located upon the above described premises, (for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in sawing said wood) now owned by said Columbia Logging Company, and A. J. Surbeck as Trustee; of said county, to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles, or other timber, lumbar or shingles herein described.
