NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that A. W. Boland of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of logs located on what is known as the T. J. Vail place and Camas Tract in Section Six (6) Township ^{one} (1) North, Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, and also in rafts or log boom of the said company in the Columbia River adjacent to the above premises, all near Prindle, Skamania County, State of Washington, being about One hundred forty thousand (140,000) feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are marked thus V R C and located on the above described premises, for labor performed upon, and assistance rendered in trucking and logging; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner is the Columbia Logging Company; that Olaf Lundy employed said A. W. Boland to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: The said Olaf Lundy agreed to pay the said A. W. Boland for such labor and assistance the sum of \$5.00 to \$7.00 per day; Dollars; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said A. W. Boland, who performed labor upon and assisted in logging and trucking said logs for the period of nine days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said above described property between the 4th day of August, 1929 and the 30th day of October, 1929; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 30th day of October, 1929, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is Four Hundred Eleven & no/100 Dollars: that no part thereof has been paid except One Hundred Ninety-eight & 51/100 Dollars and there is now due and remained unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of Two Hundred Twelve & 49/100 Dollars, in which amount he claims a lien upon said property hereinbefore described. The said A. W. Boland also claims a lien upon all of said logs located upon what is known as the Vail place and Camas Tract in Section Six (6) Township One (1) North Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian and also in rafts or log boom of the said company in the Columbia River adjacent to the above premises, all near Prindle, Skamania County, State of Washington, being about One Hundred forty Thousand (140,000) feet in quantity, which were marked thus _____ and located upon the above described premises, now owned by said Columbia Logging Company, and A. J. Surbeck as Trustee, of said county; to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
