

Notice of Location of "Crescent No 1" Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years on the 14th day of July 1898 discovered a vein or lode of quartz or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 6th day of August 1898, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length with surface ground three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode situated in the Copper Creek mining District County of Shumanna and State of Washington and known as the Crescent No 1. Mining claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft. The exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to-wit: 1000 feet east of Tinos mine on East Fork of Lewis River -

Commencing at this notice of location which is posted at a point where vein was discovered bring the south end center stake. thence 1500 linear feet in a north westerly direction to a point bring the north end center stake. Thence south westerly 300 feet to a stake bring the north west corner.

Thence south easterly 1500 feet to a point bring the south west corner stake. Thence 300 feet north easterly to place of beginning. Thence 300 feet north easterly to a point bring the south East corner stake. Thence northwesterly 1500 feet to a point bring the north east corner stake. Thence south westerly 300 feet to the north center stake and that bounded on south by Crescent No 2 and that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws and the customs and rules of mining and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
