NOTICE OF LIEN CLAIM.

Notice is hereby given that Ray Bunch of Cook, Skamania County, Washington claims a lien upon a quantity of logs being about 130 M feet marked with letter S and now in boom in Drano Lake said County and State; the lien is claimed for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in booming, rafting and preparing boom sticks and breaking jam; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is A. M. Bolter; that said A. M. Bolter employed the claimant to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said A. M. Bolter agreed to pay the said Ray Bunch 25 cents per M feet for rafting, \$5.00 for making boom sticks and \$4.00 for breaking jam; that said labor was performed between the 6th day of July, 1930, and the 19th day of July, 1930. That said contract has been faithfully performed and complied with on the part of the claimant and there is now due him for such labor and assistance the sum of \$41.50 over and above all just credits and off sets. The said claimant also claims a lien on all the piling and logs and spars now owned by said A. M. Bolter to secure payment for the work and labor performed as herein stated.
