NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that ARVID R. MATTSON of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon six brails of fir saw logs, being about 300,000 feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and marked thus; FT, and are lying the Columbia River, as follows:

Three brails of which are lying in the Columbir River near the north bank thereof, about 1½ miles East of the Interstate Bridge at Vancouver, Washington, along the north bank of said river and adjoining the real estate of the Hidden Brothers; and the other three brails of said logs are situated and lying in the North side of the Columbia River adjoining the bank of the property of the Sisters of Charity of the House of Providence, and below the sawmill owned and operated by the DuBois-Matlack Lumber Company, below the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Bridge at Vancouver, Washington, which said claim is for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in obtaining, securing, transporting, hauling logs and operating a caterpillar tractor, hauling and transporting said logs and building private roads over which said logs were hauled, in Skamania County, State of Washington.

That the name of the owner or reputed owner of said logs is F. W. Fowler, and the Fowler Logging Company.

That the said F. M. Fowler, and the Fowler Logging Company employed the said Arvid R. Mattson to perform said labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the said F. M. Fowler, and the said Fowler Logging Company promised and agreed to pay the said Arvid R. Mattson for such work labor services and assistance rendered the sum of 75 cents per hour for each hour from the 14th day of March, 1930 to the 1st day ^{last} of May, 1930; and the sum of \$1.00 per hour for such work, labor, services and assistance rendered from the ^{last} day of April, 1930 to and including the 17th day of July, 1930.

That the said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Arvid R. Mattson, who performed labor and rendered services and assisted in operating a caterpillar tractor and hauling said logs and transporting said logs, and building a private road in Skamania County, State of Washington, over which said logs were hauled, for the period of from the 14th day of March, 1930 to the 17th day of July, 1930, first and last days inclusive, aggregating in all 800 hours.

That the said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs and operating said caterpillar tractor in hauling and transporting of said logs and preparation of said private road for transportation thereof, between the 14th day of March, 1930 and the 17th day of July, 1930, both days inclusive; that the

rendition of said services was closed on the 17th day of July, 1930,

; and that thirty days have not elapsed since that time: That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$716.25; That no part thereof has been paid excepting \$253.17; and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just debts and offsets, the sum of \$463.08, for which amount the said Arvid R. Mattson claims a lien upon said logs to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said logs, spars or other timber herein described.
