NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that FRANK C. PRANTE, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon six brails of fir saw logs, being about 300,000 feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County State of Washington and marked thus: FF, and are lying in the Columbia River, as follows:

Three brails of which are lying in the Columbia River near the north bank thereof about 1½ miles East of Vancouver, Washington, along the north bank of said river and adjoining the real estate of the Hidden Brothers; and the other three brails of said logs are situated on the north side of the Columbia River adjoining the bank of the property of the Sisters of Charity of the House of Providence and below the mill owned and operated by the DuBois-Matlack Lumber Company, below the Spokane, Portland &

Seattle Railway Bridge at Vancouver, Washington, which said claim is for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in obtaining, securing, transporting, hauling, operating a donkey engine, hauling and transporting said logs and building roads over which said logs were hauled, in Skamania County, State of Washington.

That the name of the owner . . . reputed owner of said logs is F. M. Fowler, and the Fowler Logging Company. That the said F. W. Fowler, and the said Fowler Logging Company employed Frank C. Prante to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said F. M. Fowler and the said Fowler Logging Company promised and agreed to pay the said Frank C. Prante for such labor and assistance the sum of \$5.00 per day for each day of work or portion thereof.

That the said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Frank C. Prante, who performed labor upon and assisted in operating a donkey engine, hauling said logs, driving and transporting said logs and building the road over which said logs were hauled, for the period from the 21st day of April, 1930 to the 14th day of July, 1930, both days inclusive, aggregating in all 428 hours. That for each day's work under said contract of employment eight hours was the agreed length of time for each day's work.

That said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs, and in hauling and transportation of said logs and preparation of the highway for transportation thereof, between the 21st day of April, 1930 and the 14th day of July, 1930, both days inclusive; That the rendition of said services was closed on the 14th day of July, 1930, and that thirty days have not elapsed since that time; That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$264.50; That no part thereof has been paid excepting \$80.42; and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just debts and offsets, the sum of \$184.08, for which amount the said Frank C. Prante claims a lien upon said logs to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
