Homestead Certificate No. 1101 Application No. 25-88

The United States of America. To all to whom These presents shall come - Greeting:

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain", and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Peter McLane has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to Law, for the South East quarter of the North West quarter and the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section four in Township one North of range five East of the Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory containing eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:
