NOTIJE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the Undersigned, Roy Lerum, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon Six (6) brails of F ir S aw Logs, being about 300,000 feet board measure in quantity, which cut or manufactured in Skamania county, State of Washington, and marked FF, and are now lying in the Columbia River, as follows:

Three (3) Brails of whic?, containing about 150,000 feet, board measure are lying in the Columbia River near the north bank thereof, about 15 miles East of the Interstate Bridge at Vancouver, Washington, along the north bank of said river and adjoining the real estate owned by Hidden Brothers, formerly known as the Ryan D. L. C., and the other three (3) Brails, containing about 150,000 feet board measure, of said logs are situated and are now 1 ing in the said C olumbia River, near the North Bank thereof, and adjoining the real property now owned by the Sisters of Charity of the House of Providence, and below the saw mill owned and operated by DuBois-Matlack Lumber Company, below or down stream from the Spokane, Intland and Seattle Rail Way Fridge, and below the Westerly limits of the City of Cancouver, Washington, Which said claim is for labor performed upon and rendered in obtaining, securing and cutting said logs and in building roads over which said logs were hauled and transported from the place where they were cut in Skamania County, Washington.

That the name of the owner or reputed owner of said Logs is F. M. Fowler, doing business as Fowler Lagins Company, and that the said Powler Logging Company has or claims to have some interest in said logs;

That the said F. M. Fowler and the Fowler Logging C ompany employed the claimant, the said Roy Lerum, to perform said labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the said F. M. Fowler and the said Fowler Logging Company promised and agreed to pay to Claimant, the said Roy Lerum, for .ch work labor, services and Assistance rendered the sum of \$5.50 per day of Eight (8) hours, for each days work or labor furnished and performed by claimant.

That pursuant to said agreement, claimant commenced to work for said F. M. Fowler and Fowler Logging Company in getting out said logs on the 22nd day of April, 1930, and continued to so work and furnish labor and assistance in the cutting and removing of said logs and in building roads over which said logs were to

be transported from the place where they were out down to and including the 17th day of July, 1930.

That the said contract has been faithfully perform? and fully complied with on the part of this claimant, who performed labor and rendered services and assited in cutting and securing said logs and in building a private road in Shamania loundy, Washington, over which said to a were hauled, for the period of 65 days, commencing April 22, 1930, and Enging on July 17, 1930 both days inclusive, and that by reason thereof the said F. M. Fowler and Powler Logging C ompany became indebted to claimant in the full sum of Three Hundred Fifty-seven and 50/100 (\$357.50) Dollars.

That the redition of said labor and the rendering of such assistance rendered in cutting and securing said logs and in building said roads ceased on the evening of July 17, 1930,

That Thirty (30) days have not elapsed since the the day claimant ceased to perform labor and render assistance in cutting and setur in said logs as above specified:

That the amount of Claimant's demand for said labor and serviced is \$357.50; That no part thereof has been paid, and that there is now justly due and remaining after deducting all just debts and offsets, the full sum of \$357.50, unpaid thereon the full sum of \$357.50./for which amount the said Roy Lerum, the claimant herein, claims a Lien upon said logs to secure payment for the work, labor and assistance rendered and performed in cutting, obtaining and securing said logs as herein above described.
