

# Gray Eagle Claim. Copper Creek Mining District.

To Whom it May Concern.

Notice is hereby given That L. B. Blough Citizen of the United States of America conforming to the mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local rules regulations and customs of miners has located and by this notice does locate claim known as the 'Gray Eagle' Lode or mining claim. Said claim being discovered the 6th day of November 1899 and does claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes the apex of which be within said bound aries.
