NOTICE OF LIEN CLAIM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That Ben Lewis of Skamania County, State of Washington claims
 a lien upon a lot of logs and piling located on the beach in the river at Cook, Washington,
 being about 25,000 feet of logs and 51 pieces of piling which were cut or manufactured in
 Skamania County State of Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in
 hauling said logs and piling from Smith & Monaghan camp at Willard, Washington to the beach
 at Cook Washington; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is L. H. Smith and Wm. Monaghan
 co-Partners doing business as Smith & Monaghan; that the Wm. Monaghan employed Ben Lewis
 to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions
 to-wit:

That the said Wm. Monaghan agreed to pay the said Ben Lewis for such labor and assistance
 the sum of Fifty (\$.50) cents per hour and that said claimant worked 210 hours between
 the 28th day of July, 1930 to the 26th day of August, 1930; that said labor and services were
 faithfully performed and thirty days have not elapsed since the completion of said services
 that the total amount of claimant's claim and demand for said services is the sum of \$105.00
