Smith and Wm. Monaghan, co-partners doing business as Smith & Monaghan; that the Wm. Monaghan employed K.L. Hauser to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That the said Wm. Monaghan agreed to pay the said K.L. Hauser for such labor and assistance the sum of \$294.69
